

English 111 and ENG 011 Advising Suggestions for Spring 2022

Advising for ENG 111 continues to be a challenge with the inclusion of RISE and the addition of ENG 011 to some student schedules. In an effort to make selections clearer to students who use newer technologies, such as EAB Navigate, new designations for courses continues to be streamlined. Three advising points are covered in this hand-out.

“C for Co-requisite Designation”

-In Spring 2022, a letter C has been added to some sections of ENG 111 to designate spaces available within that class available to students who need to also take the corresponding ENG 011 co-requisite. To try and remain consistent with the ratios in place for those students who need the co-requisite and those who do not, only a limited number of co-requisite seats are available in any ENG 111 class. To make this point clearer, the corresponding ENG 011 course has the same number and a C added as well.

If students do **not** need the co-requisite course, they will sign up for the option that follows:

If students **do** need the co-requisite course, they will sign up for the option that follows:

“Comments Provided and Suggestions Offered”

For advising purposes, **WebAdvisor** will continue to have available language that lets students (and/or advisors) know which section of ENG 011 is delineated for any given ENG 111. Sample language follows below:


co-requisite class for ENG-111-FJC01

EAB Navigate will automatically suggest a certain section of ENG 011 based on the section of ENG 111 selected. Unlike **WebAdvisor**, however, **EAB Navigate** will not display a message to

indicate if an ENG-111 section is connected to an ENG-011 section until students add a section to their term planners. Thus, advisors should add direction about whether to select a co-requisite section in the “Send Comment” field that appears when sending suggested courses to students. The comment field suggestion follows:

When registering for an English 111 course, please note that a supplemental course (ENG 011) is required. The supplemental course is designed to support your success in this course. Failure to register for ENG 011 will prevent you from registering for ENG 111, and a specific section is prescribed for the ENG 111 selected.

“Changing if a Co-Requisite is No Longer Needed”

As with other ENG 111 classes, to try and remain consistent with the ratios in place for those students who need the co-requisite and those who do not, only a limited number of co-requisite seats are available in any ENG 111 class. Sometimes our students who are currently enrolled in ENG 002 are able to make it through all ten units, which means they no longer need the co-requisite that they may have already registered for earlier in the semester.

If this happens, students should drop the “C” course and register for the non “C” version of the course. So, if Sally Student is taking ENG 002 in Fall 2021, it is best to advise her to register for the ENG 111 and ENG 011 as she may be uncertain which unit she might finish in Fall 2021. If she only gets through *unit six (requires ENG 111/011)*, she will stay in the two classes that follow:

ENG 111 – FJC01 and ENG 011-FJC01

If she makes it through *unit ten (does not require ENG 011)*, however, she should drop the ENG 011 and switch over to the class that follows:

ENG 111-FJB01

This is part of the same class for which she was originally registered; however, she is now no longer in one of the co-requisite seats and not in danger of being purged as she no longer needs the ENG 011 either.
